Facts About Petrol – 1

In today's world petrol (fuel) decides and designs the economic status of a nation, more fuel consumption the life becomes more expensive, this article will summarize some facts behind the petrol price and initiate thoughts about the same,

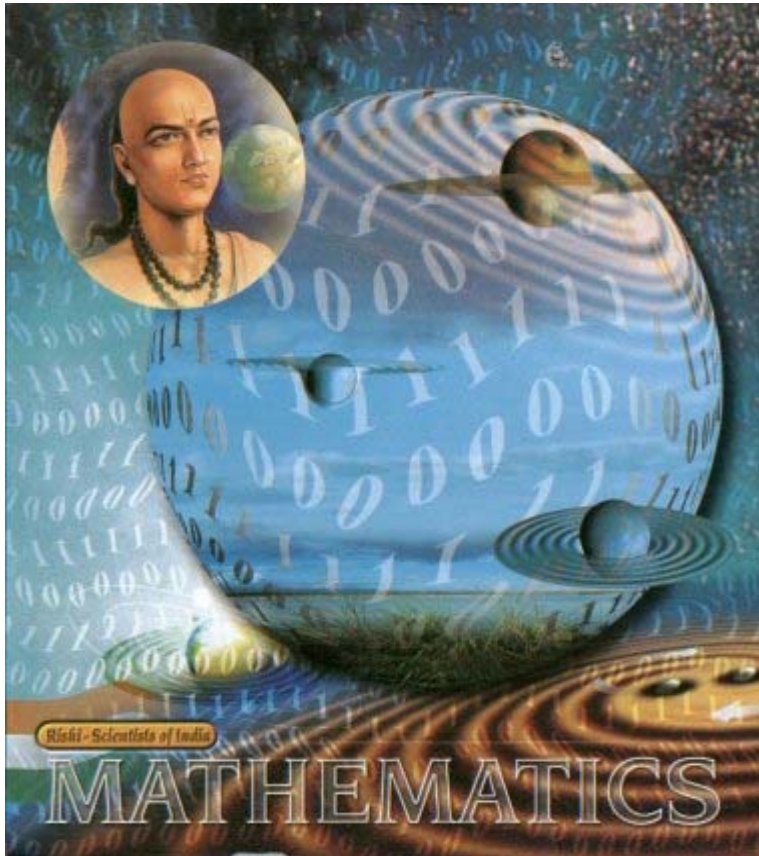
To begin with, the average gain in a barrel of crude oil is shown:

What a barrel of crude oil makes.

Product	Gallons per Barrel
Gasoline	19.4
Distillate Fuel Oil <small>(Includes both home heating oil and diesel fuel)</small>	9.7
Kerosene-Type Jet Fuel	4.3
Coke	2.0
Residual Fuel Oil <small>(Heavy oils used as fuels in industry, marine transportation, and for electric power generation)</small>	1.9
Liquefied Refinery Gases	1.9
Still Gas	1.8
Asphalt and Road Oil	1.4
Petrochemical Feedstocks	1.1
Lubricants	0.5
Kerosene	0.2
Other	0.4

Figures are based on average yields for U.S. refineries in 2000. One barrel contains 42 gallons of crude oil. The total volume of products made is 2.6 gallons greater than the original 42 gallons of crude oil. This represents "processing gain."

Born in 476 CE in Kusumpur (Bihar), Aryabhata's intellectual brilliance remapped the boundaries of mathematics and astronomy. In 499 CE, at the age of 23, he wrote a text on astronomy and an unparalleled treatise on mathematics called "Aryabhatiyam." He formulated the process of calculating the motion of planets and the time of eclipses. Aryabhata was the first to proclaim that the earth is round, it rotates on its axis, orbits the sun and is suspended in space - 1000 years before Copernicus published his heliocentric theory. He is also acknowledged for calculating π (Pi) to four decimal places: 3.1416 and the sine table in trigonometry. Centuries later, in 825 CE, the Arab mathematician, Mohammed Ibna Musa credited the value of Pi to the Indians, "This value has been given by the Hindus." And above all, his most spectacular contribution was the concept of zero without which modern computer technology would have been non-existent. Aryabhata was a colossus in the field of mathematics.

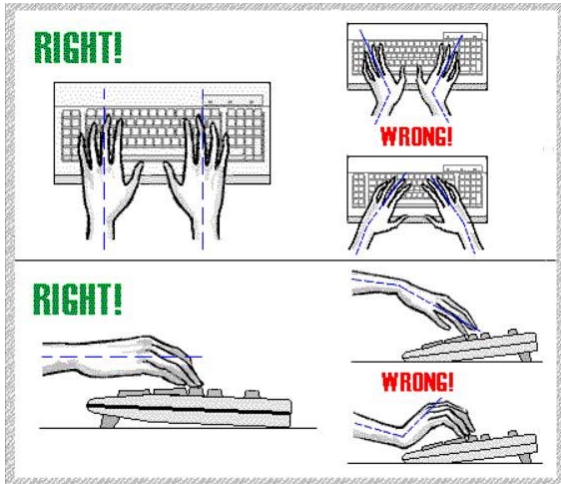
History of Souraashtras - 1

Prof. C.S. Krishnamoorthy

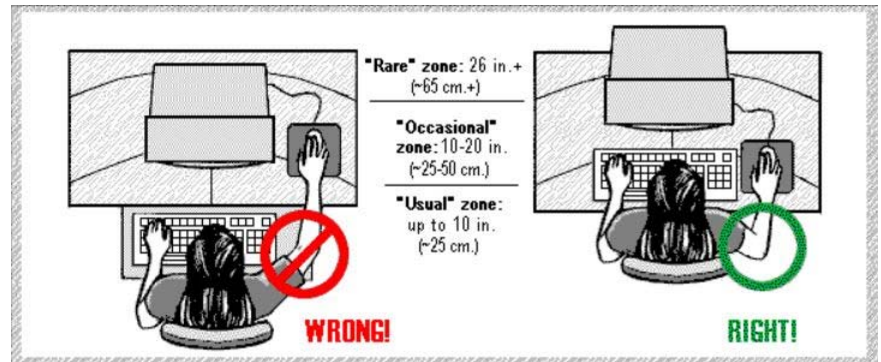
I am, Prof.C.S.Krishnamoorthy, M.A., [History], M.Phil., M.Ed., [Retd.], I did my regular Ph.D., in the University of Madras during 1978-1981, under the guidance of Dr. K.V.Raman [Head of the Dept. of Ancient History & Archaeology]. Unfortunately, I could not submit my thesis and acquire the Ph.D.Degree. This happened so, for want of sufficient, reliable sources of information to my satisfaction [I mean the standard level of Ph.D.]. After 30 years, I have resumed my work with the intention of bringing out an authentic account on the Origin, Stages of Migration and social life for the time being. My interest in the work has received a further impetus on the birth of RISHI [Research Institute of Sourashtra Heritage and Immigration] under the strenuous efforts of Er. T.L.Parasuram and Smt. Radha Parasuram M.A. [USA].

In the forthcoming issues, I will be sharing some of the historical aspects of the History, Origin and the Cultural aspects of Sourashtra (our) community people.

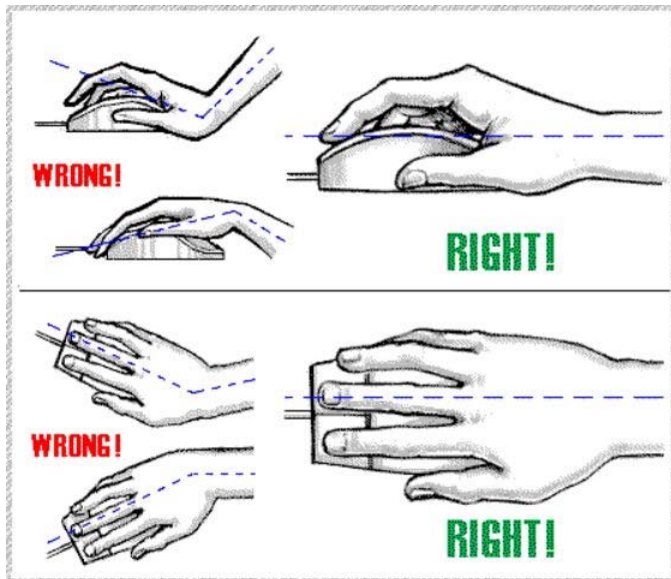

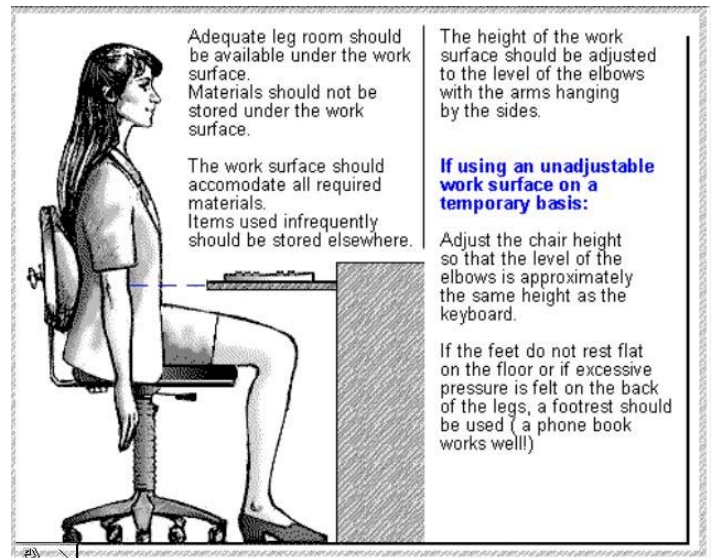
